1. Apologies for absence

None, as everyone was present.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting

The minutes of the meeting held on 11th July 2024 were read and agreed as an accurate record. Copies had been distributed to all Trustees and Parish Councillors.

3. Matters arising

There were no matters arising.

4. Report of Secretary

The Secretary reported that the Committee held six meetings during the year. The Committee has continued to receive funding from Hunton Parish Council for those parts of the field not separately maintained by the sports clubs and would like to thank the Parish Council for its support. The amount received in 2024/25 was £7,000.

The Committee has continued to keep the field well maintained through: grass cutting; strimming; hedge cutting; and bin emptying.

Over the past year, a bench has been installed in the fenced play area for parents to sit on, a gate has been fitted in the fencing between the old changing rooms and the cricket pavilion and potholes in the car park have been filled.

The fenced play area has been kept locked for several months due to repairs required to the multiplay, which were more extensive than originally envisioned.

The play area is inspected on an annual basis by a Register of Play Areas International (RPII) qualified inspector and a trustee carries out monthly play area inspections now that Maidstone Borough Council no longer do them.

5. Election of Trustees and Secretary

All Trustees were re-elected. Sharon Goodwin was happy to continue as the Secretary. Proposed by Colin Slattery and seconded by David Heaton, she was elected unanimously.

6. Election of Chairman

Colin Slattery was happy to continue as the Chairman of the Trustees. Proposed by David Heaton and seconded by Simon Taylor, he was elected unanimously.

7. Governance of Trust

The Trustee Indemnity insurance has been renewed for 2025/26.

The 2026 AGM of the Committee will take place at least three weeks after the Hunton Annual Parish Meeting to enable it to be given due publicity.
