1. Welcome

Health & Safety

There was no current Play Area Inspection Report to consider at this time.

Other Parish Matters and Parish Plan

The Parish Plan Steering Committee had plans well in hand for the event to be held on 18 September. The Sports Clubs using the Field each agreed to sponsorship event in the sum of £25.00 per Club. Monies should be sent to Simon Taylor.

Other Matters

A request had been received from a local resident for the use of the Field as a venue for a Wedding Reception to be held in 2011. Following discussion by the Committee it was agreed that there would be no problem with this subject to all the necessary Event and Public

liability insurance being in place. KE would make further contact with the persons concerned.

Parish Matters

The Parish Clerk would follow up on progress of the proposed Gateways on West Street. The poor state of West Street at the bottom of Hunton Hill was discussed at the recent Parish Council Meeting and Cllr Parr planned to have a meeting with Highways to get the matter resolved.

Any Other Matters

It was noted that the emptying of bins on the Field continued to be a problem. The Parish Clerk would be asked to establish exactly what service is provided by MBC.

Allan Bishop reported on the improvements currently being carried out to the Village Hall.
