5.1 Mistletoe Cottage, Grove Lane - 19/505867/FULL

Demolition of existing garage and erection of two single storey buildings providing a garden store with glazed link to annexe ancillary to main dwelling. Parish Council recommendation: No objection.

6.2 St Mary's Church West Street - 19/504236/LBC

Listed Building Consent for the installation of a small wooden hut, within the grounds of a listed building, to house a compost toilet. Parish Council recommendation: No objection. Maidstone Borough Council decision: Application withdrawn. 6.3 Former Grain Store, Burford Farm, Redwall Lane, Linton - 19/505195/PNQCLA Prior Notification for proposed change of use of agricultural building and land within its curtilage to 3 no. residential dwellings and for associated operational development. For its prior approval to: - Transport and Highways impacts of the development - Contamination risks on the site - Flooding risks on the site - Noise impacts of the development - Whether the location or siting of the building makes it otherwise impractical or undesirable for the use of the building to change as proposed - Design and external appearance impacts on the building. Parish Council recommendation: Refuse. Maidstone Borough Council decision: Refused.
